<p><u>Target</u></p> <p>Make up your own game with a target. Players add up their total score to see who wins.</p>	<p><u>Cooking</u></p> <p>Cook or bake something. Measure the ingredients yourself, set the timer on the oven or micro-wave.</p>	<p><u>Number Walk</u></p> <p>Go on a number walk outside. Where can you find numbers? What are they? What is the biggest number you can find? The smallest?</p>
<p><u>Spare Change</u></p> <p>Find the spare change pot at home. Count the coins. Group the coins. How many of each coin is the same as 10p, 20p etc?</p>	<p><u>Board Game</u></p> <p>They can plan and make their own board game to be played. They must write a set of instructions to go with it.</p>	<p><u>Model Making</u></p> <p>They can make a model of their choice by selecting different 3-D items to make it. Can they name all of the 3-D shapes?</p>
<p><u>Computer Skills</u></p> <p>Can your child use Excel to produce their own graph? They must select a theme and collect their data first.</p>	<p><u>Measuring</u></p> <p>Measure a set of objects, record the measurements and then decide how to order these lengths.</p>	<p>Or something else, you decide!</p>
