Year groups: Years 1 and 2

Start Date: 3rd June 2019
End Date: 14th June 2019

2 weeks

Main Subject Focus:

Geography

Supported by this/these subjects:

Discrete Subjects:

Guided Reading, Phonics, Grammar, Literacy, Maths, French, PE and Music.

Rationale:

This is an opportunity for the children to learn about the human and physical features of their local area.

Hook:

What can we discover in our local area?

Outcome:

Create a map of the local area using symbols for the human and physical features.

How the values will be fostered:

- Resilience: children will work through learning and remembering what each symbol represents. They will apply these to new learning on the topic as it presents itself.
