**Main Subject focus:**

Art

**Discrete Subjects:**

**Rationale:**

Children will have the opportunity to develop their techniques, including their control and use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art. They will use sketch books to record observations and use them to review and revisit ideas; improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing with a range of materials. This learning experience will also enable children to study Kadinsky, one of the great artists in history.
