Main Subject focus:

Science

Discrete Subjects:

Guided Reading, Spelling, SPaG, Maths, Music, ICT, PE, PSHE.

Rationale:

This is an opportunity for children to learn about light and how it travels. They will draw and build upon what they have already learnt in Lower Key Stage Two. They will investigate reflection and how the eye works and what the different parts of the human eye are called. Children will also be given the opportunity to investigate shadows further and think about how they are cast.

Hook:

Can you describe how our eyes use light?
